Dear Parents and Carers,

As the end of another busy term approaches, I thought it timely to provide our school community with a newsletter to ensure you are aware of upcoming dates and information.

He has always been student focused and the changes he has made to the delivery of curriculum, well being and the physical learning environment will be well remembered. SCHOOL OPENING HOURS

Many students are arriving to school before 8:30am. I would like to stress to parents that the school is not open to students prior to 8:30am. Please remember that if staff are on site before this time, they are preparing lessons and attending meetings.

Your child's safety is an absolute priority to us, so please note that supervision for students does not begin until 8:30am. If you require *Before School Care*, there are options in Gunnedah where the students are delivered to school by bus at the appropriate time. Please call the office if you are unsure of before school care providers and the ladies will assist you.

ATTENDANCE

Can I please remind parents and carers to inform your child's teacher of all absences as soon as possible. You can enter an explanation via schoolstream, respond to daily sms, write a note or simply call the school office on 6742 1899. If your child is going to be away from school for an extended period of time, please call and we can explain the criteria and process for the completion of an Extended Leave form.

ANZAC DAY MARCH

The ANZAC Day march will commence from 10:30am on 25th April. Students are to meet at the **Mitre 10 carpark from 10am**. All students should wear their full summer uniform including their school hat and are asked to carry a drink bottle.

UNIFORM: SUMMER TO WINTER

For the first 2 weeks of next term, students are able to wear either summer or winter uniforms depending on the weather. We ask that students are wearing their full winter uniform by the beginning of Week 3, Monday 8th May.

COVID 19 Update: All students should have received a supply of rapid antigen tests this week, so you are equipped to test your child if they are unwell or displaying symptoms. Please see the advice below from the Department of Education in line with Health NSW: *Remember: Staff and students should stay home if they are unwell.*

* If COVID-19 symptoms occur, your child should undertake a rapid antigen test (RAT).

* If a student is unwell and has any COVID–19 symptoms, even the mildest of symptoms, they should always test for COVID-19.

* If the test comes back negative for COVID-19, the student should still not return to school until either: The student no longer has any symptoms, or a medical certificate is provided to the school confirming that symptoms are explained by another diagnosis (such as hay fever).

Congratulations to Mrs Rebecca Higgins who has been successful in gaining the position of Assistant Principal of Kootingal Public School. Mrs Higgins arrived at South as a classroom teacher in 2016 and spent many years as a relieving executive before becoming a permanent assistant principal in 2020.
