IMPORTANT NEWS

SOUTH SCHOOL is transitioning to a new communication platform!

During term 3 & 4 our school will be transitioning to a new communication platform to align us with updated finance systems. This requires parents and carers to add an app to their smartphone or preferred device. We ask that parents and carers take the time to be set up and ready for this new system. The school will continue to update everyone as the transition progresses.



Here is how you can get ready in the next few weeks.

Firstly, download the **NSW Education Parent App** to your smart phone.

When you first launch the app, you will be prompted to add a school. You will then be presented with a number of onboarding screens to educate you about the app's functions. The sections are:

- News and Newsletters: Get the latest activity and newsletters from the school(s) you are following.
- Calendar: View a calendar of past and future events (weekly or monthly).
- School essentials: Access the latest apps for your school, contact the school and make payments.

Stay notified: Let school(s) notify you of news and events by tapping the 'Okay' button.

School Bytes

Once the NSW Education Parent App has been downloaded and you open the details for Gunnedah South School. There will be a section called "MORE LINKS" which is where School Bytes will appear. The first use will require you to create a new account. Simply follow the prompts.

More information regarding School Bytes will become available as functions are enabled.

School Stream will be phased out at the end of term 3, so please help us by being ready.

Please don't hesitate to contact the office if you require assistance with this set up.



DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE A MEDICAL CONDITION?

If your child has been diagnosed with a medical condition that can occur at school, we need to know.

With Spring just around the corner, Asthma can be tricky. If your Doctor has provided an Asthma plan, it is important that we have a recent copy on our system. If your child presents to our sick bay, our staff need to ensure your child is given the appropriate care needed. Please make sure that your child has their Ventolin or Asmol puffer with them in their school bag. Any heath care plans that you have already supplied the school, please make sure that they are up to date. If you require to make a payment after this time, payments can be made through our school website https://gunnedahs-p.schools.nsw.gov.au, under the *make a payment* banner.






School Bytes



While we are still using Schoolstream for now, we are encouraging our parents to download our new School Bytes app. Student Absences can be put through on School Bytes and go straight to your child's classroom teacher.

Semester 1 school reports have now been uploaded to the app. If you are having trouble with linking your child/ren,

please call the school office and staff can help with the process. Please make sure that we have your correct email address as all permission notes will now come through via the School Bytes app.



Voluntary Contributions or 'school fees' have now been attached to student accounts. Fees are \$40 for the eldest child, \$20 for the second and \$10 for any additional siblings. Voluntary contributions go toward classroom supplies including books, pencils, kitchen supplies for class cooking lessons etc. Fees can be paid through the school office or via the School Bytes app.
