Dear Parents and Carers.

Life Ed Van- There was a buzz of excitement throughout the student population this week as they await the return of Healthy Harold and the Life Education Van. used for any school communication. Please make sure you are ready for this change by completing the steps outlined on the following page. Uniform- over the next two weeks, all students may wear either full summer or winter uniform. Please remember that girls are to wear white socks with their summer uniforms and boys grey socks. IMPORTANT NEWS

SOUTH SCHOOL is transitioning to a new communication platform!

During term 3 & 4 our school will be transitioning to a new communication platform to align us with updated finance systems. This requires parents and carers to add an app to their smartphone or preferred device. We ask that parents and carers take the time to be set up and ready for this new system. The school will continue to update everyone as the transition progresses.



Here is how you can get ready for the complete change over by the end term.

Firstly, download the **NSW Education Parent App** to your smart phone.

When you first launch the app, you will be prompted to add a school. You will then be presented with a number of onboarding screens to educate you about the app's functions. The sections are:

- News and Newsletters: Get the latest activity and newsletters from the school(s) you are following.
- Calendar: View a calendar of past and future events (weekly or monthly).
- School essentials: Access the latest apps for your school, contact the school and make payments.

Stay notified: Let school(s) notify you of news and events by tapping the 'Okay' button.

School Bytes

Once the NSW Education Parent App has been downloaded and you open the details for Gunnedah South School. There will be a section called "MORE LINKS" which is where School Bytes will appear. The first use will require you to create a new account. Simply follow the prompts.

More information regarding School Bytes will become available as functions are enabled.

School Stream will be phased out at the end of Term 3, so please help us by being ready, and don't hesitate to contact the office if you require assistance with setting up.

Year 5 students are excited to have become the guardians of the new trees around GSPS.














































To help the new trees thrive, we will be ensuring that each tree gets watered daily.


